Dream, Believe, Learn and Achieve...

This half term looks amazing!

We will be exploring lots of exciting topics this half term.

English

This term, we will be continuing our theme of our world and the environment, looking at stories about animals and plants. We will continue building on our sentence punctuation and also learn to use conjunctions to join sentences. We will also learn about using capital letters for names. We will keep using our speaking and listening skills to help us to say a sentence before we write it. We are continuing to read decodable books from Little Wandle, appropriate to our phonic level, and to practise key sounds and tricky words.

Maths

We will use our knowledge of place value to 20 to help us to add and subtract within 20. We will need to know our number bonds to 10 to help us build on number facts to 20. We will use tens frames, part-whole models and number lines to help us count.

We will also continue with learning quick 'Mastering Number' strategies in the afternoon.

RE

We will learn about salvation in Christianity. We will tell stories of Holy week and Easter and make a link with the idea of salvation.

Science

We will continue our topic on materials (e.g. wood or glass, etc.) and how they are used in a variety of different everyday objects. We will also describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials and use this to compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties. If the good weather arrives, we may also look at the season of spring.

History

We will complete a study of the UK by looking in detail at its four nations – England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. We will also look at our local area and our school grounds.

ICT

We will complete our Purple Mash unit on Lego Builders, and then begin looking at Lego Maze Explorers and animated story books.

DT

This half term, we will be learning about simple sliders and levers and how we can use them to make a simple greetings card.

SMSC/PSHE

We will be learning about how to keep ourselves healthy and happy for the future.

PE

We will continue our unit on dance, using the music of the *Lion King* and explore the use of space, direction, level and speed and mirroring. On Thursdays, we will be continuing our unit on 'attack, defend and shoot' where we use our ball skills and our awareness of space with an opponent.

Music

We will be continuing our musical skills with Mr Walters.
