This half term looks amazing!

Our topic this half term is 'Once upon a time' so our learning will be loosely based around this theme.

Literacy

In Literacy, we will begin by looking at the story 'Zog'.

In phonics we will consolidating the phonemes and graphemes that we have already learnt and applying them to longer words and sentences.

Maths

In Maths, we will be exploring counting beyond 20, doubling numbers and odd and even number patterns.

We will extend our learning on number bonds to cover bonds to 10.

RE

In RE, we will be learning about how and why churches are important places to Christians.

Understanding the World

In UTW, we will begin exploring idea concept on past, present and future. We will start by looking at Yoxall in the past and will examine photographs and other sources. We look at how things have changed across the recent and more distant past.

We will be linking our previous learning on 'How big is the world?' to food sources and where different foods come from.

During Welly Wednesdays, we will learn about different flowers, shrubs and trees.

Expressive Arts and Design

In DT we will be exploring food tasting and preparation.

In Art, we will be learning about how we can use our bodies to make art in different ways.

Our Jigsaw topic is 'Relationships', we will learn about:

PE

In PE, we will be studying 'Manipulation and Coordination'. We will be learning to:

- Send and receive
- Coordinate different parts of our bodies
