The FOSPS Trustees are delighted to announce that last week we handed over a cheque to the school for £5404.92. This donation is in relation to the following:

- Covering the full cost of the coach to the Pantomime in December
- Subsiding Autumn term trips and in-house workshops
- The purchasing of maths equipment, which will be an enormous edition to the school's learning resources and leveraged by all year groups

In addition to the above we have continued to make "regular" contributions including the crackers for the Christmas dinner, subscription for the online library and the Easter bonnet prize. We have also agreed to fund the redevelopment of the sensory garden and are in discussion with the school for making further donations, which will be discussed at the next FOSPS meeting.

Following the successful disco last week, so far, this academic year FOSPS have raised £6645. Some of our biggest earning events have been:











Fundraising






